Friday Night games at Foyle Kling Field bring in crowds of several thousand people to see some of the best AA football in New York State.

Football has been played at Lancaster since 1919 (91 seasons). The program has only known two coaches over the past 50 years, the past 25 years under the guidance of 1969 graduate Len Jankiewicz. Lancaster has a record of 139-88-2 through Coach Jankiewicz's 25 year career. Lancaster has produced 71 ALL New York State Players and has had 17 Championship seasons through the years. In addition to being a perennial football power, the Lancaster Football Program has been ranked in the top three in WNY in the scholar athlete program eight times since 2000, including the #1 ranking in New York State in 2002.
